

Update - 3/4/2021

Per the governor's guidelines, FACE MASKS ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE FACILITY

The Wilmington Ice House remains committed to the safety and well-being of our employees and patrons. We continue to follow all guidelines set forth by the CDC, the state of North Carolina and New Hanover County. Please read the following measures we will be taking to protect everyone entering the facility:

- **Anyone experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, cough, shortness of breath) is required to stay home.**
- **FACE MASKS ARE REQUIRED for anyone age 5 or older. Masks must be worn at all times. Masks are also required while skating: including hockey, figure, and public skating.**
- **Patrons will not be allowed into the facility until 30 minutes prior to the start of an event and must clear out of the facility within 30 minutes of the end of an event.**
- **We are operating under a max capacity limit. We are NOT booking birthday parties or large groups. Not accepting reservations. Public Skate is first come first serve.**
 - **We are NOT booking birthday parties or large groups. Public skate is first come first serve. No reservations accepted.**
- **Locker rooms will be thoroughly sanitized after each use.**
- **Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the facility.**
- **Restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized at least once per hour.**
- **Employees will be required to wear masks at all times and wash or sanitize their hands regularly. They will have their temperature taken prior to clocking in. Any employee experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 will be required to stay home.**
